



SOUTHERN ZAMBIA ROUTE

**LIVINGSTONE (VICTORIA FALLS),
LOWER ZAMBEZI,
KAFUE AND SOUTH LUANGWA**

Start off by spending time at Victoria Falls, one of the seven natural wonders of the world. Then head up to the Lower Zambezi National Park, and using a canoe, explore the wildlife on the banks of the Zambezi River. Kafue is next, the oldest and largest of Zambia's National Parks. Final stop is South Luangwa known as 'one of the greatest wildlife sanctuaries in the world'. Not bad for only 15 days!
